## SPRA Membership Fees & Cancellation

Any request to cancel Association membership outwith the 'regulated cancellation period' (see following), will be considered in accordance with the Association's constitution and related rules, terms and conditions. A copy of these are available at [www.srapol.co.uk](http://www.srapol.co.uk).

The Association constitution (as at December 2018) records:

### "5 MEMBERSHIP FEES

#### 5.1 MEMBERS

5.1.1 The Annual Subscription of Member and all Membership types shall be as agreed by the Finance Board and ratified by Executive Committee in open meeting.

5.1.2 In the event of the Renewal Subscription of a Member not being paid by 31<sup>st</sup> March of any year, then that Membership will be deemed to have lapsed.

5.1.3 The minimum membership period for all membership types, other than temporary membership, shall be one year.

5.1.4 There shall be no refund of Subscription.

### 6 CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

6.1 In the event of an Ordinary Member, Retired Member, or Associate or Affiliate Member ceasing to qualify for Membership as defined in Article 3 hereof, or on relinquishing or being required to relinquish his/her Membership, then any Spouse or Family Membership granted in tandem to such Ordinary, Associate or Affiliate Membership, shall cease with immediate effect. In such an event there shall be no recourse to the Association.

6.2 Notice of resignation is to be in writing and to take effect four weeks from the date of receipt by the Chief Executive"

## NOTICE OF THE RIGHT TO CANCEL



### *RETIRED MEMBERSHIP*

You have the right to cancel your application for membership, as a contract to which these regulations apply, within 14 days without giving any reason. The regulated cancellation period will expire after 14 days from the date on which you sign your application (the commencement of the contract). To exercise the right to cancel, you must inform us of your decision to cancel this contract by a clear statement (e.g. a letter sent by post or email). (Postal Address: SPRA Office, 6 Baird Street, Glasgow G4 0EZ, E-mail: [spra@srapol.co.uk](mailto:spra@srapol.co.uk) ).

You may use the following cancellation form, but it is not obligatory. To meet the cancellation deadline, it is sufficient for you to send your communication concerning your exercise of the right to cancel before the cancellation period has expired. The notice of cancellation is deemed to be served as soon as it is posted or sent to SPRA, or in the case of electronic communication from the day it is sent to SPRA.

If you cancel this contract within the regulated period, we will reimburse all payments received from you. We will make the reimbursement to you by bank transfer or cheque; in any event, you will not incur any fees as a result of the reimbursement. If you requested to begin the performance of services during the cancellation period, you shall pay us an amount which is in proportion to what has been performed until you have communicated to us your cancellation form this contract, in comparison with the full coverage of the contract.
